



Nyboder Museum is worth a visit

You will find the little NYBODER MUSEUM in the oldest part of Nyboder, in the one-storey wing from King Christian IV's time in the early 17th century.

Here you can learn about life in Nyboder and experience the humble and modest living conditions for a Nyboder family at the start of the 20th century.

The little museum is run by the association **Nyboders Minde**, which consists of members having a connection with Nyboder.

In cooperation with Nyboders Headquarters and the Maritime Museum the association has been allocated two houses in the old wing to use as a museum, including a newly built school room in the courtyard, and a foyer housing a model of Nyboder.

The museum, foyer, the school room's renovation and the new building were supported by the A. P. Møller's Fund with 1.6 mill. DKK.

Following previous agreement it is possible for groups to have a guided tour in English of the house and hear a talk on Nyboder.
